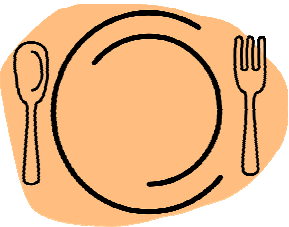

Mark your calendar and be sure to take part in the annual BUILD Celebration event, where we will be celebrating our 15th anniversary of seeing justice together. (MPC has been involved with BUILD for 5 years). We will have dinner together at 6:15 p.m. and the program will begin at 7:00 p.m. As a group of 26 congregations from throughout Lexington, this is our chance to celebrate the community we share, the accomplishments we've made as an organized movement for justice, and the work we will continue to do to draw our city closer to a community that reflects God's vision for creation. We will also be kicking off the annual investment drive, where congregation members who feel passionately about supporting the work of BUILD in other ways beyond being a presence and a voice in our ongoing efforts can make a commitment to financially support BUILD. The money BUILD receives (through grants, congregational investments, individual investments, and corporate investments) includes covering the cost of our staff, various training opportunities for any member of BUILD, and usage fees for Heritage Hall. As a congregation, we have invested \$1,000.00 to the work of BUILD in 2018 through our Mission Fund. On top of our congregation's investment, you are encouraged to join Scott in making a personal investment. We have set a goal of investing an additional \$1,000.00 of support for BUILD.
